## **Patrick Howe Oil Painting Class Supplies**

In my classes you can use your own painting supplies, or purchase my recommended supplies.

**Items most frequently forgotten by students:** Paper towels (at least 12 sheets) Cardboard to mount your loose canvas sheets on A watertight glass jar with lid. Get stiff BRISTLE brushes, not soft floppy brushes.

Where To Buy Online: Amazon, Jerry's Artarama, Blick, or elsewhere online.

**Brick and mortal:** Artist and Craftsman Supply, 4350 8th Ave NE, Seattle, WA 98105. Blick Art Materials: 1600 Broadway, Seattle, WA 98122 (Most hobby stores, like Michaels, or Hobby Lobby, may not have the all the supplies. Take your chances). In most art supply stores, if you mention you are my student, they will give you a 10% discount.

**Paint** There are 2 paint options: 1) Gamblin's Artist Version colors. Or, 2) Gamblin's Student 1980 Series colors. I recommend the Artist Version colors. They are more expensive but there is more pigment in the tubes. But if you are on a budget, then the Student 1980 colors (1980 Series) will work just fine too.

Buy Colors (Either in Gamblin Artist Colors or Gamblin 1980 Series colors).Size: 37 ml tubesCadmium Red MediumCadmium Yellow Medium

Ultramarine Blue Ivory Black Dioxazine Purple Cadmium Orange Titanium Zinc White (Ok to substitute Titanium White, **but No Zinc White**) Phthalo Emerald (**NOTE**: **ok to substitute Phthalo Green**, *only if* **necessary**. **No Emerald Green**)

Medium: Gamblin Galkyd Light, 4oz (Get smallest size)
Solvent: Gamblin Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirits (No substitute) 16oz 8 oz
Solvent container: Canning jar (any small watertight jar)
Paper Palette: Disposable Paper Palette Pad, 9" x 12". White recommended.
(12" x 16" ok for substitute) (Gray ok only for substitute). (Paper palette not to be confused with canvas pad below).

**Canvas Pad:** Buy "*REAL*" Canvas Pad, 9" x 12" (*Do not purchase any canvas that has the word "Paper" anywhere on the packaging*).

**Do not get Blick brand canvas pad.** Blick has a lot of great art supplies, but their canvas pads are inferior. Instead, get Fredrix, or Art Alternative, or US Art Supply brand canvas pads.

**Brushes** (See important informations about brushes toward bottom of webpage) Get stiff bristle brushes, not floppy brushes.
